Hakone Odawara

H25 Hot spring steamed red bean paste bun

「Hakone no Otsukisama」
温泉まんじゅう「箱根のお月さま。」
〈Nanohana / 菜の花 (P19 E-1)〉

Housemade buns prepared by a traditional process with carefully-chosen ingredients from all over Japan.

H32 Okashi no Uirou

お菓子のういろう
〈Uirou / ういろう (P19 G-6)〉

More than 600 years ago, the Uirou family invented this steamed rice flour dessert to serve to state guests. The dessert became popular and spread all over Japan, taking on the "Uirou" family name in the process. It features a chewy texture and slight sweetness.

H20 Coasters of Yosegi zaiku

寄木コースター
〈Yosegi Uchiyara / よせぎうちらは (P18 C-6)〉

The coaster of Yosegi Zaiku (wooden mosaic) crafted by young artisans, are popular for their modern patterns in which the original colors of the wood are used effectively. The coaster, being washable with water, are suitable for everyday use.

〈Odawara Ejima / 小田原 江嶋 (P19 H-5)〉

Deeply steamed green tea, one of the most popular green teas from Kakegawa in Shizuoka, that is steamed two or three times longer than regular Sencha. The longer steaming brings out rich flavor and aroma, the taste is mild with less astringency. Tasting available.

K27 Hato Sable

Very famous cookie from Kamakura made by blending carefully-selected ingredients and then baking to perfection. It has a delicious savory and buttery flavor.

K5 Kamakura-bori Kokagami (small mirror)

鎌倉彫 小鏡
〈Hakkodo / 博古堂 (P26 B-2)〉

Their kokagami are lightweight and come in a convenient, portable size with more than 20 designs to choose from. You can also enjoy the gradual changes in the carving and lacquer as you use it over time. They make perfect souvenirs or gifts from a Kamakura trip!

K24 K25 K26 Kamakura hakkei

K29 Ume-hana Hanpen 梅花はんぺん

These hanpen are modeled after plum blossoms blooming in the city of Kamakura. Enjoy their flavorful taste and chewy, soft texture. They are delicious as-is or dipped in wasabi soy sauce!

K8 Kamakura Dorayaki

(red bean paste pancakes)

Dorayaki is designated as a sweet of Kanagawa Prefecture. It is an excellent combination of red bean paste sandwiched between two pancakes using a traditional process.

〈Kamakura Inishienishi / 鎌倉いにしえにし (P26 B-3)〉

A roasted sweet potato dessert wrapped in a washi (traditional Japanese paper) with seasonal patterns that resembles a kimono. Enjoy the abundant natural sweetness and velvety texture of their sweet potatoes, which have been aged for several months in a stone storehouse.

You can enjoy walking on the open beach in the park which faces the coastlines of Yuigahama and Inamuragasaki. On sunny winter days, you can clearly see Enoshima island as well as Mt. Fuji from the observatory of Inamuragasaki.
