"Yokohama" is a sophisticated port town with skyscrapers, one of the world's largest China towns, and the Yamate Western-style Building, where you can find exotic culture.

Including Landmark Tower, the high-rise building with an observatory floor, a shopping mall, an amusement park, museums and more, the area is always delighted with many visitors. 
