

## Daiyūzan Saijō-ji temple

This temple, with over 4000 different schools across Japan, is known as a sacred ground in the Kanto region with a history of 600 years. Rows of cedar trees that are more than 500 years old and designated as a prefectural natural monument can be found in the grounds of this famous temple. You can experience shojin ryori (traditional vegetable dishes for Buddhist monks) and zen meditation (reservations required).

# Komyo-ji Temple (head temple of Jodo sect)

This temple was founded in 1243 by the Jodo sect's third patriarch, Nen-a Ryochu. The temple gate has been designated as a Nationally Important Cultural Property. You can enjoy a panoramic view of the town of Kamakura, Sagami Bay, Enoshima Island and Mt. Fuji from the top of the hill behind the temple. This view has been selected as one of the 50 most picturesque views in Kanagawa Prefecture. Shojin ryori (traditional vegetable dishes for Buddhist monks) of your choice can be prepared If you reserve in advance.


#### Kamakura Noh Theatre

## Japan Open-air Folk House Museum


