Facility Overview

This tourism hub offers information on sightseeing in Odawara and provides unique content that allows visitors to experience the region's traditional cultures. In addition to various experiential workshops, the facility also has a café, a museum shop, bicycle rentals, and rental spaces. The structure itself is built from cypress and cedar from Odawara.

Highlights

Visitors can see some of Odawara's traditions and cultures first-hand, including Odawara lanterns, wood mosaic work, and seafood rice bowl samples. Fun for both adults and children, visitors can turn up on the day without booking to enjoy Odawara's charms.

Details/Schedule

- Food sample rice bowl workshop: 1,980 yen; Required time: Approx. 1 hour
Choose seven types of fake food samples to stick together to create a seafood rice bowl sample.
- Wood mosaic coaster workshop: 1,320 yen; Required time: Approx. 20 min.
Create a coaster using the wood mosaic technique, a traditional craft from Odawara and Hakone. Participants can create the coaster using their favorite colors and shapes.
- Odawara lantern workshop: 2,420 yen; Required time: Approx. 1 hour 30 min.
Select one of ten different designs featuring Odawara landscapes to create an Odawara lantern.
