Tokaido Glass Workshop


























Facility Overview

Just a few minutes' walk from Keikyu Kawasaki Station, this glass workshop can be found on the site of the old Kawasaki-shuku station along the former Tokaido road. Here, visitors can experience the traditional kiriko glass-making method. Great for beginners, visitors can choose their favorite variety from a range of different glasses and plates and speak to instructors about specific designs. The resulting products can be taken home as souvenirs.

Highlights

The classroom itself is in a beautiful renovated building that was previously a sake wholesaler's shop. The glass products are made using two different types of grinders, and the kind and careful guidance from the instructors and small number of participants makes it an ideal experience for beginners.
