Facility Overview

Extending throughout the Tsujimura Forest, Forest Bike opened in 2018 as the sister facility of Forest Adventure Odawara. Promoting a symbiotic relationship between the forest and mountain biking, this mountain bike park offers a casual environment in which to enjoy the trails. Instructors provide detailed initial training to ensure visitors can ride safely. There are a variety of different trails for different abilities to ensure even experienced mountain bikers can enjoy the facility.

Highlights

- There are a total of 14 off-road courses that can be selected based on the rider's level, from the Oval Course for beginners to the Jump Trail where intermediate and advanced riders can enjoy dynamic, free-flowing routes.
- Visitors can enjoy the beauty of the surrounding nature in all four seasons.

Details/Schedule

- Initial Safety Training A: Bike inspections, basic knowledge, basic posture, braking methods, gap-jumping methods, etc. Training is for approx. 90 min., the remaining time is for riding
 - Initial Safety Training B for intermediate and advanced riders: Confirmation of course information and points of caution with an instructor. Technique checks apply. Training is for approx. 40 min., the remaining time is for riding
- *Half-day riding, full-day riding, private lessons are also available
