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## Facility Overview

This long-established beef hotpot restaurant was founded in 1895 in Isezaki-cho. It grew in popularity thanks to its well-loved catchphrase, "Delicious flavors of Japan's westernization for the price of a streetcar ticket," and having overcome the Great Kanto earthquake and the bombing of Yokohama, it continues to be a popular spot among different generations today.

## Highlights

While the restaurant's signature dish is the beef hotpot simmered in a secret soup containing sugar, soy sauce, mirin, and sake, the restaurant also offers various other popular dishes including shabu shabu, simmered beef, beef skewers, and steak and rice.
