CHABAKKA TEA PARKS is a specialty tea shop that focuses on carefully selected single-origin Japanese tea from across Japan. Based on the concept "Japanese tea entertainment," the shop offers cold-brewed sencha, known as "draft tea," served through beer servers, fixed price delivery of carefully selected single-origin Japanese tea once a month, and other new ways of enjoying Japanese tea.

## Highlights

Customers can serve themselves beer-like cold-brewed sencha, called draft tea, from beer servers.
