### Explanation of Tourist Attraction

In 1970, this "Kawamura Noh Theater" was established for the purposes of renaissance and popularizing of "Noh", the traditional Japanese performing art (UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage). Kamakura Noh Theater presents Nohgaku performances several times a year. Kamakura Noh Theater also functions as a mini-museum and displays Noh masks, Noh costumes and fans.
