# Nissan Motor Corporation Yokohama Plant

Explanation of  
 Tourist Attraction

In 1933, Nissan Motor Corporation was founded in Yokohama as an integrated automobile manufacturing plant handling everything from parts manufacturing to final assembly. An engine development and production base, the plant also produces engines and suspension parts, and electric vehicle and hybrid engines. On this tour, you can see the Nissan MR engine production line. At the Nissan Engine Museum, visitors can see a total of 28 engines of various generations, including engines that were used in races. The museum also holds demonstrations, such as a drawing demonstration by one of Nissan's production robots. Reservations are required for plant tours. Please inquire for details.

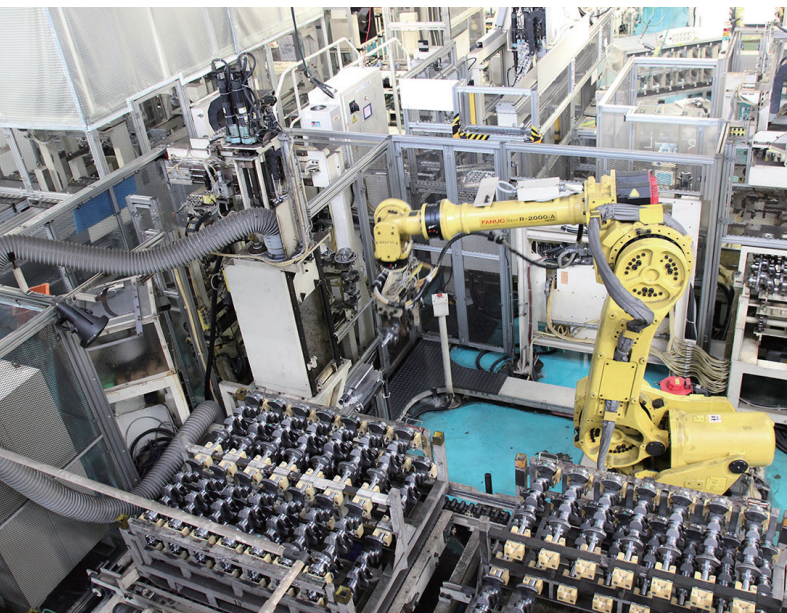

Access

A 17-minute walk from JR Shin-Koyasu Station or Keikyu Shinkoyasu Station. Take the city bus from Shin-Koyasu Station, staying on for about 10 minutes before getting off at Takaracho. Car (Metropolitan Expressway): From Tokyo, take the Moriyacho Ramp. From Yokohama, take the Koyasu Ramp. Either route takes about 2 minutes.
