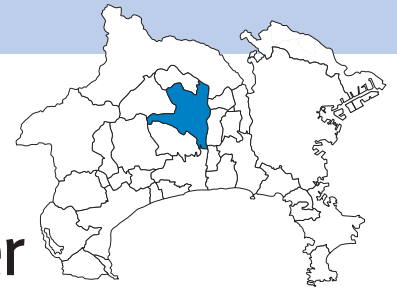

Explanation of
Tourist Attraction

The Kanagawa Prefectural Disaster Prevention Center was established in April 1995 as a base for disseminating knowledge about disaster prevention. To properly prepare for a disaster, it is crucial to know and think about the disaster. The disaster prevention information/experience floor has various disaster prevention information exhibits as well as a corner where you can experience earthquakes, storms, and floods firsthand.

selling point

In the earthquake experience corner, realistic shaking in three directions is reproduced, and you can experience a simulated earthquake with a seismic intensity of up to 7. In addition, there is a corner where you can experience storms, floods, smoke evacuation, and extinguishing a fire.
