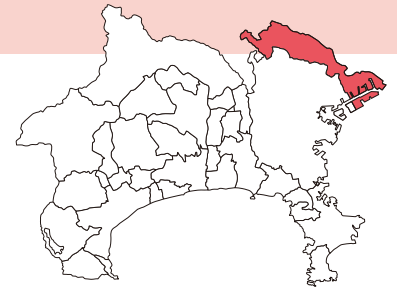

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

This facility processes industrial waste discharged from factories, hospitals, construction sites, etc. Visitors can check out waste storage pits and see how waste is carried to incinerators with cranes. The site is visited by a variety of people including school officials, companies, self-governing associations, and women's associations. We can accommodate up to 50 people for one tour, which lasts about 90 minutes.

selling point

This is a form of "study tourism" where you can learn how industrial waste is properly disposed of. It also welcomes school trips for visitors both from Japan and abroad.
