Yokohamabashi-dori Shopping District

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

The Yokohamabashi-dori Shopping District was opened in 1928 and claims 90 years of history. It consists of 130 stores selling fresh fish, daily food necessities, ingredients for Chinese cuisine and Korean cuisine, etc. Around one-third of these stores sell fresh fish and approximately half of the remaining stores sell daily food necessities, and it is has flourished as the "kitchen of the proletariat" since ancient times in downtown Yokohama as a district selling local food that can be consumed on the spot. The area is visited by many foreign visitors who live locally, and this helps give it an international atmosphere. Located approximately three-minutes' walk away is the Miyoshi Engeijo theater for the ancient form of Rakugo comedy, and the Edoya cafe serving Japanese confectionary, which is patronaged by famous Rakugo artist Katsura Utamaru, is a popular spot in the district.

Gyu Nabe (Beef Hotpot)



Gyu Nabe (beef hotpot) is said to represent the roots of the famous sukiyaki dish, and it originated in Yokohama together with the spread of civilization and enlightenment throughout Japan. This restaurant is a well-established spot in Yokohama, having been founded more than one-hundred years ago, and the cuisine it serves enables customers to taste traditional flavors.

Sky Garden observation deck on the 69th floor of Yokohama Landmark Tower



One of Japan's leading observation decks located 273m above sea level. Not only does it provide beautiful panoramas of Yokohama Minato Mirai, it also provides views of Tokyo Skytree and Mt. Fuji on clear days.
