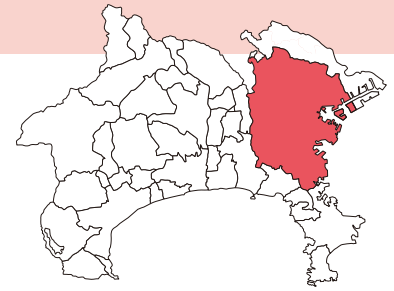

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

This zoo is focused on promoting harmony with nature. Divided into eight zones representing the different climatic zones and regions of the world, there are 110 animals of 640 species on display, including a variety of rare animals from across the world. With exhibitions focused on different habitats and the various climatic zones and regions of the world, this zoo takes visitors on a trip around the world. A great place to learn about plants and the natural environment. The largest zoo in Japan, Zoorasia exhibits, cares for, and breeds wild animals from around the world. The zoo is also involved in research aiming to reintroduce rare species on the verge of extinction to the wild. On weekends and holidays in August, Yokohama's zoos (Zoorasia, Nogeeyama Zoo, and Yokohama Shiritsu Kanazawa Zoo) offer special tours of the zoo at night, when they are usually closed to the public. Adults: ¥800, high school students: ¥300, elementary school students: ¥200, admission free for children under elementary school age.
