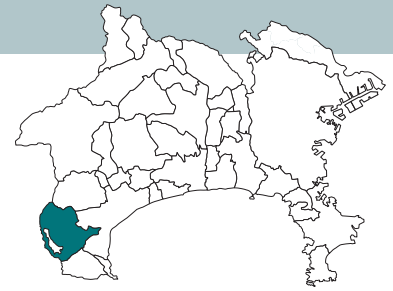

Hakone Wood Mosaic Parquetry (Hatajuku Parquet Hall)



Explanation of Tourist Attraction

Parquetry is a woodworking technique that combines various types of wood to create a pattern with the differences in color. At this Hall, the local Hakone traditional parquetry is displayed and sold, and you can see how parquetry is actually made here in Hakone, which has flourished around the Hata-juku area since the Edo period. If you join a workshop, you can make your own parquetry coaster following a craftsman's instructions and using pre-prepared materials. A reservation is required for the workshop.

Amazake Tea House



This tea house has been passed down for 12 generations since it opened in the Edo period. Their specialty is homemade amazake (Sweet Sake) made without any sugar or additives. They also sell soft and delicious rice cakes that have been pounded and then grilled over high-grade charcoal. The thatched-roof adds to the relaxing atmosphere.

Hiryunotaki Falls



This is the largest waterfall in Kanagawa, with the flowing water separated into two waterfalls: the upper falls are 15 meters long and the lower falls are 25 meters. There is a legend from the Kamakura period that says that the body can be cleansed by standing under the falls.
