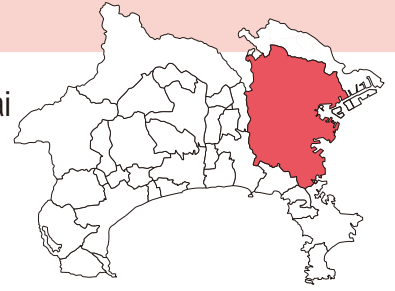

Tourist Attraction

This is a facility where you can enjoy SUP on the Ooka river, which is famous for its beautiful cherry blossom trees. SUP (stand-up paddle) is surfing on a large board using a hand-held paddle, and is getting popular as a fitness sport. Since the water area in Yokohama was developed utilizing canals, it is protected by the wind, and the water is always calm, which is easier for beginners. Also, guides familiar with the area will help you so you can enjoy safely.

selling point

SUP stands for Stand-Up Paddle surfing. This never-before-seen activity was invented in Hawaii. Anyone, including those who are not particularly well coordinated, can enjoy this, because all they need to do to go forward is to stand on the board and row with the paddles.
