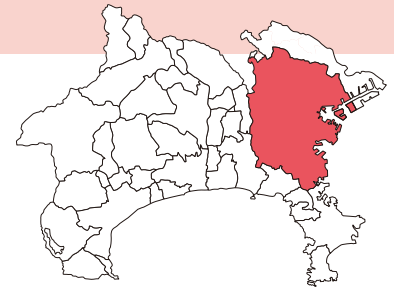

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

This mansion consists of five structures including a Nagaya-mon gate with a thatched roof and a main hermitage, which were built during the last years of the Edo era. In mid April to May, they put up Koinobori or carp streamers in their front yard and in September, bamboo forests are illuminated, creating fantastic scenery. From May, rice production classes are also held, so you can feel the rural life close by. Enjoy the seasonal flowers and traditional Japanese events.
