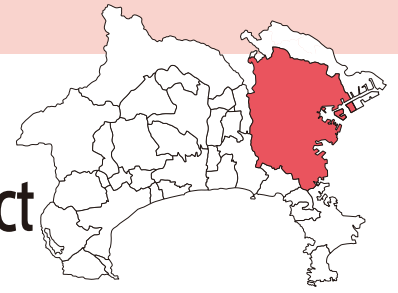

# Rokkakubashi Shopping District (Dokkiri Yami Ichiba)



### Explanation of Tourist Attraction

This is a triangular-roofed arcade in a small alley. This shopping district consists of retro style shops, such as fresh produce shops, antique watch stores and used bookstores from the Showa era. A total of 170 shops are lined up in the center part of the shopping street. Dokkiri Yami Ichiba is held nightly on the third Saturday of each month from April through October. The flea market is held after the end of the business day, when all the shops are closed. Live performances are held at empty stores and parking lots. Visitors can enjoy the deep roots of subcultures through the various events held. The popular "Shopping District Pro-Wrestling" was derived from here.

### selling point

Rokkakubashi Shopping District's "Dokkiri Yami Ichiba, the night time flea market" is held on every third Saturday at 8PM from April through October (except August).
