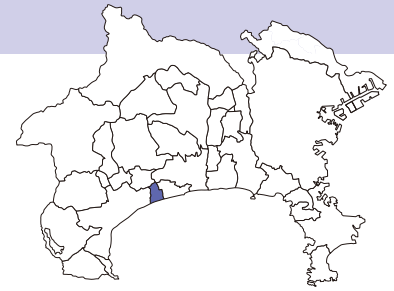

Azumayama Park



Explanation of Tourist Attraction

Azumayama Park is known for "feeling the arrival of spring early" due to its early blooming of canola flowers. The grass-covered gentle slope enables visitors to enjoy a 360 degree view by Sagami Bay. Walk five minutes to the park entrance from Ninomiya Station, north exit, then up the steps through the mountain path. In about 20 minutes, you will reach the observation deck on the mountaintop. (Altitude 136.2m) You will see Tanzawa Sanchi in the north, from the west to the south is Mt. Fuji, Hakone Mountain range, and Izu Peninsula. On the east, Oshima floats on the horizon, and you can look over Enoshima, Miura and Boso Peninsula. Visitors can observe seasonal flowers such as canola flowers (Jan.-Feb.), cherry blossoms (March - April), creeping phlox (April - May), azalea (April - May), hydrangea (Jun. - Jul.), and cosmos.

selling point

Azumayama canola flower viewing (Jan.-Feb.) Breathtaking early-blooming canola flowers that total about 60,000 plants. During the blooming period, they hold various hospitality events such as local produce markets, tsurushi-bina doll displays, and stamp rallies.

Former Residence of Yoshida Shigeru



The late former Prime Minister, Shigeru Yoshida's old residence was built by Kyoto's Miyadaiku (carpenter specializing in temples, shrines, etc.). The Japanese garden was designed by world renown designer, the late Ken Nakajima. The residence completely burned to the ground in a fire in 2009, however, it was partially rebuilt in 2012.

Kawawa Shrine



It was a history of over 2,000 years. It is known as Ninomiya in Sagami Province and also referred to as great gracious god Ninomiya or Ninomiya Myo Shrine. The name of the shrine is also the source of the town name "Ninomiya". You can view the special landscape of Mt. Fuji from the Chozuya (water ablution pavilion), wrapped in a sacred atmosphere.
