French-style gardens are typically flat and feature bilateral symmetry and geometrical ponds spread over a large area, but Gora Park was built on a slanted surface. The open park surrounded by mountains and wide-open skies is known for the many types of flowers planted here. This charming park also features a tropical greenhouse, tea house, and workshops, so you can try out many different activities.
