Hakone Ropeway



Explanation of Tourist Attraction This is a ropeway that spans between Owakudani Station and Togendai Station, at an altitude of 1000 m overseeing Hakone. They started the operation of a dual single-wire automatic circulation (DLM) funitel and visitors can fully enjoy views of Mt. Fuji. Owakudani is one of 50 most scenic spots in Kanagawa. From Souunzan Station, visitors can see Myojogatake, where they light a fire in the form of the Chinese character, "Dai"(large) on the mountainside every year on August 16. It is also called "Daimonjiyaki". You can see Mt. Fuji, which shows the facets of every season. When the sky is clear, you can even see Tokyo Skytree.
