# Lalique Museum Hakone



**Explanation of Tourist Attraction**  Rune Lalique (1860-1945), a representative artist of France who played an active role in both the Art Nouveau and Art Deco eras. He crafted original cloisonne jewelry, and won the Grand Prix at the Paris Expo in 1900. With perfume bottle production as the spark, he became a glass craftsman in his 50's, and left numerous colorful glass works from vases and lamps to interior decoration, to color everyday life. At Hakone Lalique Art Museum, you can view works spanning Lalique's lifetime.
