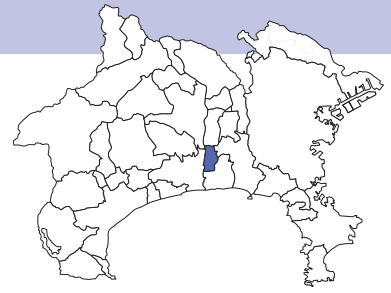

Explanation of
Tourist Attraction

The Ichinomiya Greenway was built along the abandoned railway right of way of the Samukawa branch line. Roughly 200 m of the old branch line remain, with wheels on display - an enchanting place for train lovers. You can slowly walk along the path and take pictures standing on the tracks - something not normally possible! It is especially beautiful when the cherry blossom trees are in bloom.

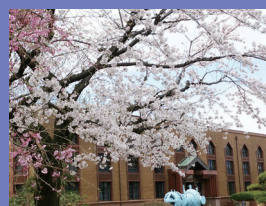
Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Samukawa Shrine, in Samukawa, Koza District, is the only shrine in Japan with a guardian deity for warding off unlucky years. Everyone is welcome to pray here, and you may feel something mystical with the solemn purification rituals held here.
