 Tourist Attraction

The Kanagawa Arts Theatre, known as KAAT, was opened in 2011 and specializes in presenting performing arts, including plays, musicals, and dance. The 1,200-seat hall features a stage with machinery and movable seats, allowing a wide variety of performances to be held here. In addition to this hall, there is also a 200-seat large studio as well as a rehearsal space. The hall is operated with these three ideas in mind: 1) Artistic Creation, 2) Training and Human Resource Development, and 3) Local Community Contribution Activities.

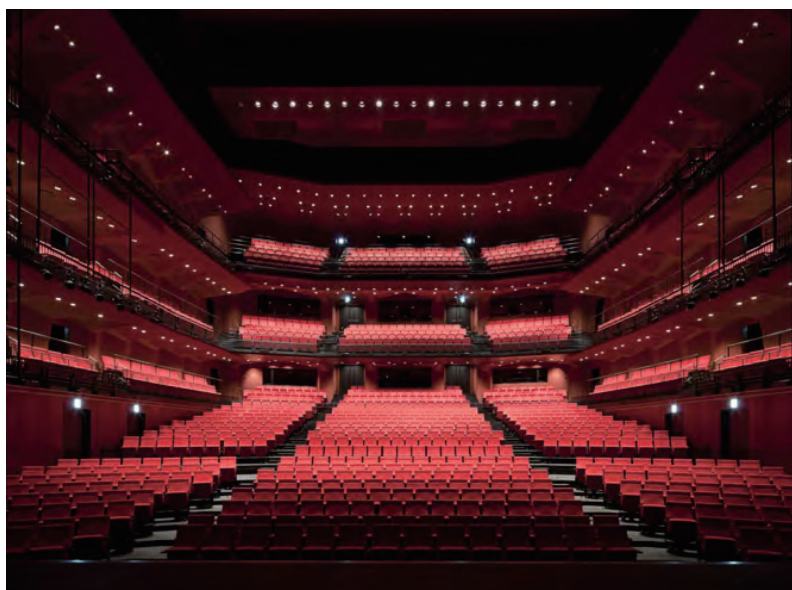

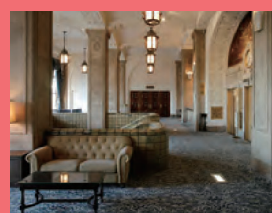

The largest Chinatown in Japan and East Asia is found in the vicinity of Yamashita-cho, Naka ward, Yokohama City. There are more than 500 shops, and 6,000 Chinese people live within an area of about 0.2km²
