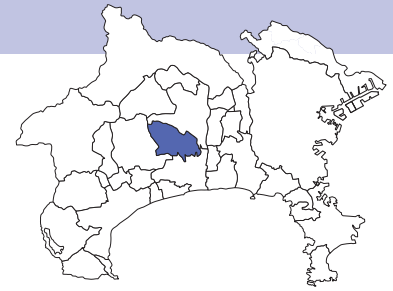

Oyama Afuri Shrine



Explanation of Tourist Attraction

Mt. Oyama is a single peak mountain located in the east edge of the Tanzawa mountains. Oyama Afuri Shrine is said to have been built 2,000 years ago. It was very popular to pay a visit to this shrine, and long ago in the Edo period, 200,000 people would visit here each year. Even today, you can see the traditions and customs of those days. At the foot of the mountain spans the largest shrine-owned guest house area in Japan. Visitors stay, and then make the journey to the summit to pay respects.

The view from the Oyama Afuri Shrine has received two stars from Michelin, and "visiting Mt. Oyama" itself was certified as a Japanese national heritage.

From bus stop 4 of the north exit of Isehara Station on Odakyu Odawara Line take a route bus bound for Oyama-Cable for about 30 minutes. Get off at the Oyama-Cable bus stop, the last stop for this bus. Take Oyama-Cable from Oyama-Cable Station and get off at Afuri-jinja Station.

Very doable for novice hikers as well, the view from the top reveals Mt. Fuji, Tokyo, and Tokyo's Skytree Tower. This view was mentioned in Michelin as well.

Oyama-cable



Oyama's cable car is 0.8km long, and the difference in elevation is 278m, and takes about 6 minutes to reach the top. It takes you to a spot with an elevation of 700m, and you can enjoy a wonderful view from there. You'll be able to see the far away Enoshima island, and the scrolling seasonal beauty from the windows of the car is a sight to behold, too.
