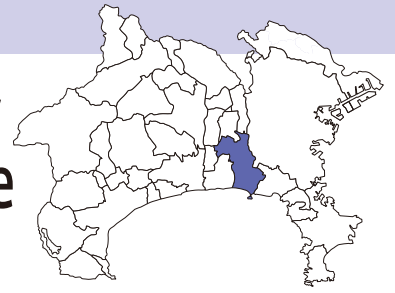

# Ji-shu Buddhism Head Temple Yugyo-ji Temple



Explanation of  
Tourist Attraction

The head temple of the Ji-shu branch of Buddhism, founded by Ippen Shonin. It's official name is Totakusan Muryoko-in Shojoko-ji Temple.

Since its establishment by Donkai, Yugyo Shonin the Fourth, the temple has been known as Yugyo-ji Temple, the home of Yugyo Shonin.

Several events are held at the temple throughout the year, including the Kaisanki Ceremony in spring and autumn. Famous as the only large wooden Buddhist temple in Tokaido, in 2015, the building was designated as a tangible cultural property. The temple is also famous for its large ginkgo tree, which is believed to be 700 years old. Today, it continues to provide citizens with a place for ascetic training and relaxation.
