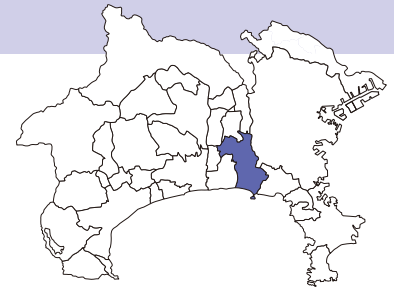

Tourist Attraction

Fujisawa city's Ukiyoe collection is centered around the pieces received from Fumiaki Kure who was a former president of Nihon University. Since then, as part of the local materials, Ukiyoe prints themed on Fujisawa-shuku and Enoshima were collected. Fujisawa are the Tokaido's Fujisawa-shuku Station and Shōjōkō-ji (Yugyo-ji) Temple, which is the head temple of Ji-shū Denomination. Enoshima and Ooyama were places of faith and excursion, as well as the entrance to the shrine. Many Ukiyoe prints were based on sights and legends from there.

Terrace Mall Shonan



Directly connected to JR Tsujido Station, north exit, this shopping mall consists of 281 shops, making it the largest mall in the area. The mall is 3.6 times the size of Tokyo Dome, bringing new shops to Shonan area including a cinema complex.
