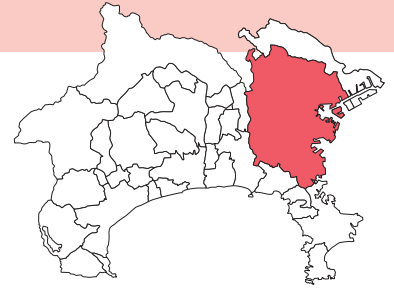

Tourist Attraction

Iseyama Kotaijingu Shrine is known as "Kanto no O-Ise-san", as the Imperial Shrine of the guardian of Yokohama, Amaterasu Oomikami. This shrine was built in 1870, shortly after the opening of Yokohama Port, to unite the people, carve out the differences between foreign and national cultures, and to pray for protection for the nation. Its first festival was said to have gotten the whole Yokohama citizens to participate in the event and showed its magnificent and grand beauty.

selling point

The cherry blossoms that bloom along the large stairs on the precincts are wonderful and the place around the tree is the site for citizens to relax. There are also other popular Yokohama sightseeing spots around Iseyama, such as "Noge Foods Alley" and "Minatomirai".

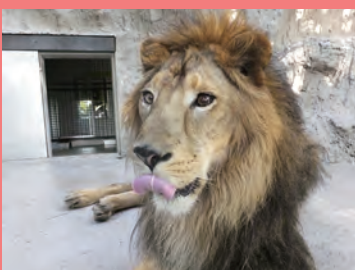
