Kinugasayama Park

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

This park opened in 1907. With about 2,000 cherry blossom trees, the park is the best place in the entire Miura Peninsula to see the cherry blossoms, and was even included in a list of Japans top ten cherry blossom viewing spots. The Kinugasa Cherry Blossom Festival, held every year between late March and early April during the cherry blossom season, draws a big crowd. The park is 7.4 hectares (18.3 acres) large, and the majority of the blossom trees are Yoshino cherry trees. With athletic equipment and a hiking course, the park is a great place to enjoy sports and other activities with the whole family.

Access

From Yokosuka-Chuo Station, take a bus bound for Nagai ("For Misakiguchi Station" or "For Nagai") (approx. 20 min), get off at Kinugasayama Park, and walk for about 10 minutes. About 20 minutes' walk from JR Kinugasa Station. Car: From the Yokohama Yokosuka Road KinugasalInterchange, it's about 10 minutes' drive (as the roads are narrow and parking space limited, we recommend using public transportation.)
