Dobuita Shopping Street



Explanation of Tourist Attraction

This shopping district is a unique combination of Japanese and American vibes. A wide variety of establishments such as military shops, souvenir shops, bars and restaurants that cater to foreigners are joined together in this building. The name Dobuita comes from the word "dobu" meaning drainage channel, and "ita" meaning slab. It's said there was a drainage channel running through the center of Honcho area, so the Navy supplied heavy iron slabs to cover it, hence the name.

selling point

Dobuita Street is the birthplace of "Sukajan (jackets with loud embroidery on the back)." The street is also famous for Navy Hamburgers, Navy Curry, and cherry cheesecake.

Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Verna Park



It is a park incorporating a French garden style, and you can see the Yokosuka Iron Works on the opposite shore. There are flowerbeds and fountains, western-style bowers, and about 1,400 rose bushes add lush colors.

Yokosuka Naval Port Cruise



Around the naval port of Yokosuka, you can see the ships of the US Navy and Maritime Self-Defense Force at close range. It is the only cruising tour in Japan.
