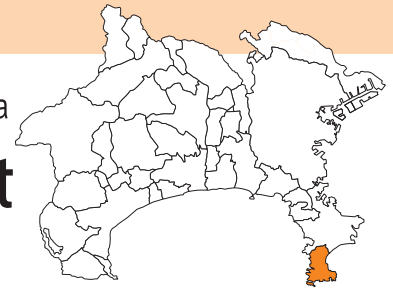

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

Koajiro harbor is a natural harbor in Koajiro Bay on the nature-rich Miura Peninsula. This harbor, which faces the Sagami Bay, flourished from the Edo period and remains a well-known fishing port even today. The Marujumaru operates from Koajiro-ko, allowing visitors to the area to enjoy fishing. Passengers aboard the Marujumaru can experience the natural scenery of Sagami Bay, Aburatsubo and Koajiro Bay from the sea.

Services/Activities

The cruise aboard the Marujumaru lasts approx. 60 minutes. The price is negotiable. Visitors can also enjoy fishing in a fishing boat.
