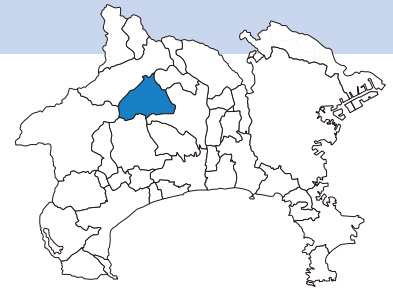

Miyagase Dam



Explanation of
Tourist Attraction

Every Wednesday and on the second Sunday and second Friday of each month, the gates of Miyagase Dam are opened for tourists to see. The gates are opened for just six minutes, discharging 30 cubic meters (1,060 cubic feet) of water per second. Visitors are treated to a spectacular scene, as an unimaginable volume of water flows through this man-made waterfall. There is also an energy museum, and a restaurant, Shiroy Taki (The White Waterfall). The restaurant serves an interesting New Dam Curry. When you pull out the wiener plug, curry flows out. Its one of the newest attractions of Miyagase.

Access

From Hon-Atsugi Station, ride the Kanagawa Chuo Kotsu bus bound for Miyagase to the final stop (aprox. 60 min). From JR Hashimoto Station ride the Kanagawa Chuo Kotsu bus bound for Toriihara Fureai no Ie to the final stop (approx. 50 min). Car: From the Tomei Expressway Atsugi Interchange, take National Route 129 (National Route 246) → National Route 60 → National Route 64 (Toward Kiyokawa) (approx. 45 min). From the Ken-o Expressway Sagami-hara Interchange, go through National Route 510 → National Route 513 → National Route 412 (approx. 20 min).

In Kanagawa, you can experience the wonder of hydro and solar electricity first hand, at the prefectures numerous renewable energy facilities, including the Aikawataiyohikari Power Station, built and managed by the Kanagawa Prefectural Enterprise Department. You can also enjoy a walk on the promenade, or a tour of the solar panels.

Lake Miyagase's Mizunosato Suspension Bridge



A tunnel of light mounted on the suspension bridge stretching over the lake. The 315 meter (1,035 foot) bridge and the 180 meter (590 foot) pathway leading up to it are illuminated with 300 thousand LED lights.
