At Japan's largest Chinatown district, in an area stretching 500 meters in all directions, you'll find over 600 shops, including Chinese restaurants, souvenir shops, and general variety stores. Not only can visitors enjoy lunches and dinners here, but also stroll among stores selling various Chinese miscellaneous goods. There are many examples of Chinese-style architecture worth seeing to be found here, including the Paifang gateways which stand to the north, south, east and west, the "Ma Zhu Miao" (a temple to the goddess Ma Zhu), which protects the seas and is a worthy addition to the Minato Mirai area, and the "Kanteibyō" (Emperor Guan's Shrine), which honors the general Guan Yu, of "Romance of the Three Kingdoms" fame.

Japan's largest Chinatown district, where visitors can stroll through over 600 shops, and enjoy dining and shopping. There is also a wide variety of events from season to season, held throughout the year.
