
There are two 20m-wide bouldering walls!

Hadano Tanzawa Climbing Park



Explanation of
Tourist Attraction

It is a bouldering facility operated by the city of Hadano. It is located in the Hadano Togawa Park surrounded by rich greenery of Omote Tanzawa. It is one of the most famous sports climbing areas along with the Lead wall and Speed wall at Prefectural Sangaku Sports Center located nearby. Bouldering wall that was used for "IFSC Climbing World Championships in 2019 Hachioji" and "2016 Kibokyo Iwate National Athletic Meet" was moved here so you can climb the wall climbed by top athletes in the world.



Selling point



30-minutes beginner class is available for people who climb for the first time. Also, the clear panel shutter opens and closes so it has open feel and prevents being close to other people.

Access

From North Exit of Shibusawa Station (Odakyu Odawara Line) take line 02 bus bound for Okura [Okura bus stop (last stop)]. Get off at Okura bus stop (last stop) and walk for 7 min.

Recommended Season

Green season (the beginning of April to the end of May),
Fall leave season (the beginning to the end of November)

are available.



Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Koboyama Park



Yabitsu Pass is located in the middle of Route No. 70 connecting to Route 246 and Miyagase Lake in Tanzawa mountains that are 761m above sea level. It is a popular spot in Hadano City where many people visit day and night.

Koubounosatoyu



It is a famous hot spring of Tsurumaki that contains one of the largest amounts of calcium in Japan. The hot spring from 1000m below ground contains sodium-calcium chloride and is effective for cuts, bad circulation, depression, and dry skin.
