Explanation of Tourist Attraction

The Kotogahama Coast is a beach that can be found on the road from Manazuru Port to Manazuru Cape Mitsuishi. The beach is lined with seaside restaurants, and is popular among tourists and families. While the beach is not suited to swimming, it is known as the birthplace of the Japanese diving scene, and is a popular scuba diving spot. The beach is famous for the luminescent algae that light up its waves in the summer. Once it gets dark, a fantastic scene unfolds, with shows of blue and white light accompanying each crash of the waves upon the shore.

Mitsuishi
