Explanation of Tourist Attraction This is a shrine dedicated to Sontoku Ninomiya (popular name: Kinjiro), the renowned agricultural administrator of the later stage of the Edo Period. Kinjiro is someone who worked his way through school and strived to reconstruct farming villages in various places. Hotoku Ninomiya Jinjya Shrine was built in 1894, and after holding a centennial anniversary in 1994, it still exists today. In the precinct, adjacent to the Odawara Castle, are interspersed restaurants and cafes; here is condensed Odawara's appeal.
