An izakaya (Japanese style pub) with the theme of “monsters” that appear in the “Ultraman” series. This sakaba was born from the concept of “a place for ultra-monsters that sometimes fight toe-to-toe with heroes, that sometimes get completely beaten up by heroes, to blow off their blues every night and to replenish their energy, in order to wreak more havoc tomorrow”. An extremely popular place since it serves as an oasis for “forever young men” who grew up watching Ultraman.

LAZONA Kawasaki Plaza



Accessible directly from JR Kawasaki Station, this is a large commercial facility with roughly 330 fashion and gourmet shops. There are also specialty shops, Japanese sweets shops, a food hall, as well as restaurants.

Cyber Kowloon City [Kawasaki Warehouse]



A large-scale game center located in front of Kawasaki Station and containing a reproduction of the Hong-Kong slums of Kowloon City. The billiard, darts, and Internet café floor is open 24-hours a day. (Free parking)
