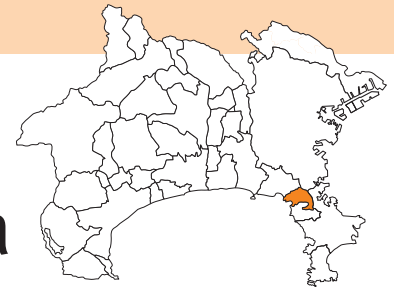

Access

Weekdays: From JR Yokosuka Line Zushi Station East Exit, take the bus bound for Kamakura Station via Kotsubo (approx. 12 min), and get off at Riviera Zushi Marina-mae Bus Stop.
From Keikyu Line Shinzushi Station, take the bus bound for Kamakura via Kotsubo (approx. 10 min), and get off at Riviera Zushi Marina-mae Bus Stop.
Weekends and holidays: From Kamakura Station East Exit, take the free shuttle bus, which departs every 15 minutes (takes approx. 10 min).
Car: Follow the Metropolitan Expressway Yokohane Route, take Yokohamashindo Road → Yokohama Yokosuka Road, heading toward Yokosuka and turning off on Asahina Interchange.
