Explanation of
 Tourist Attraction

Sarushima is the only uninhabited island in Tokyo Bay and is also the largest natural island in the bay. Visitors can enjoy barbecues and fishing, strolls around valuable historical sites and gathering shellfish in the rocks. It is an easily accessible sightseeing spot at only 30 mins walk and then boat from Yokosuka Chuo Station on the Yokosuka Line and has been designated as a National Historic Site.

The beach is open for swimming each year from mid-July to the end of August. (Boats have capacities for between 80 and 200 passengers and differ depending on the season.)

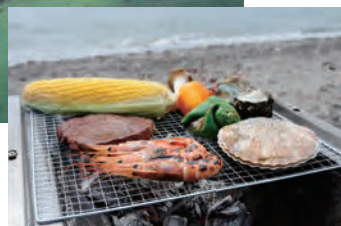
