Former Residence of Yoshida Shigeru



Explanation of Tourist Attraction This was the residence of the former Prime Minister, Shigeru Yoshida (1878-1967), where he lived after the war. His stepfather, Kenzo Yoshida purchased the land in 1884 and built the villa. After his death, Shigeru inherited the residence. He used the residence in Oiso in 1945 as his main home, where he lived the latter part of his life. This facility is a reconstruction of his residence - the reception room in 1947 and the new building designed by famous architect, Isoya Yoshida, in the latter part of the 1950's. Admission: Adults 500yen, Jr and High School Students 200yen
