# Snova Shin-Yokohama

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

Snova Shin-Yokohama is a indoor ski and snowboard park open throughout the year. The slope is around 60m in length, 30m wide and has an angle of 10 - 14 degrees. The park is kept at a temperature of -3°C, allowing visitors to enjoy the snow even during the summer. Visitors can pay an admission fee of 1,000 yen which allows them entry to the park and includes a commemorative photograph. There is also a ski school, so even beginners can navigate the slope with confidence. Rental gear is available for use. Admission fee: 1,000 yen per person. Basic slope pass (120 minutes): Adult = 3,000 yen on weekdays, 3,500 yen on weekends and holidays

Ski and snowboard lessons are available; Ski, up to 6 persons per instructor, snowboard, up to 8 person per instructor Reservation required for lesson.

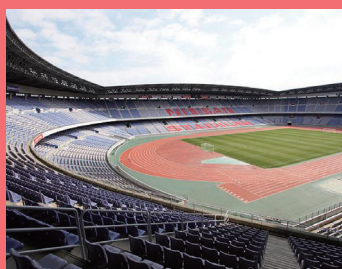
