Enoshima Shrine



Explanation of **Tourist Attraction** It is a shrine located on Enoshima island. Founded in 552, it is called Enoshima Shrine combining three different shrines, "Hetsumiya", "Nakatsumiya" and "Okutsumiya." They enshrine "Enoshima Benzaiten", which is one of Japan's three largest Benzaiten. People come here to pray for blessings in marine transportation, fishing, travel, and marriage. It was chosen as a location in a romance film some years ago, and has become even more recognized.

In the picture scroll called "Enoshima Engi", which is one of the treasures in the shrine, there is a love story about a five headed dragon and an angel, which has made this shrine a special place for marriage.
