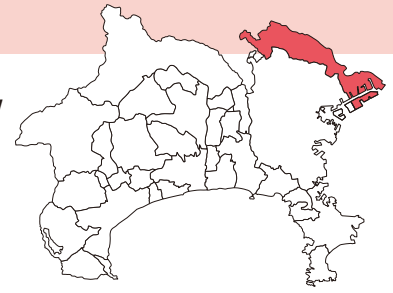

Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Kawasaki Racecourse (watch races, horse-riding experience, etc.)



An amusement spot in Kawasaki that is very popular between March and December owing to the races being held at night. The final race is not until 20:50, so it is easy to drop by even as the evening wears on. It is common to see young couples and families laying down on the well-manicured grass to watch the races.

Amusement Game Park [Kawasaki Warehouse]



A large-scale game center located in front of Kawasaki Station and containing a reproduction of the Hong-Kong slums of Kowloon City. The billiard, darts and Internet café floor is open 24-hours a day. (Free parking)
