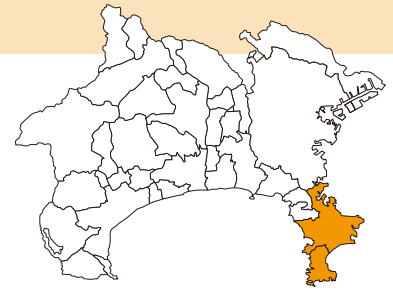

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

The garden features a bust of Oguri Kozukenosuke, a commissioner from Verny's time. It also features French-style flower beds, fountains, and Western-style arbors centered around a plaza, and is decorated with the colors of 2,000 plants of 100 varieties of mainly French roses. There is a boardwalk along the ocean, and you can enjoy walking while watching the ships floating in the sea.

Kannonzaki Lighthouse



Kannonzaki is located on the eastern tip of the Miura Peninsula, and forms the entrance to the Tokyo Bay together with the Boso Peninsula on the opposite shore. It is roughly 7 km from the lighthouse to the Boso Peninsula.

Ena Bay



Both a fishing port and a tidal flat, you can see crabs and many other animals here during low tide.
