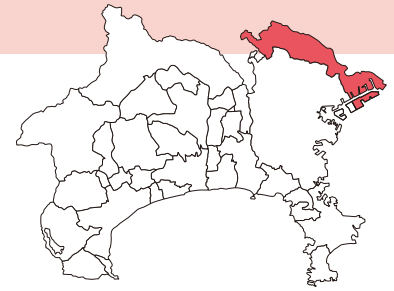

Tourist Attraction

This is a park where you can enjoy calm to thrilling attractions. Most recommended is the "Bandit", a roller coaster constructed on hilly terrain. This is a thrilling attraction on a small mountain top. You can see the high-rise buildings in Shinjuku from the Ferris wheel, and on clear sunny days, you can even see Mt. Fuji. During summer, "Pool WAI" is open which consists of three sliders and five pools. An illumination event is held during winter. In March 2016, "Good Job Attractions" opened which consists of a total of 15 fun, make-your-own workshops - including four new ones!

Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Ikuta Ryokuchi Rose Garden



Surrounded by the woodlands of Tama hills, in the spring, 530 types of roses with a total of 4700 stalks bloom and in the fall, 440 types of roses with 4000 stalks bloom. Many local volunteers come together to raise roses and manage the facility.

Nihon Minka-en



This outdoor museum was created in an effort to preserve a traditional Japanese style house at a time when many such houses were quickly disappearing. The museum is composed of 25 buildings, including houses of a style typical of eastern Japan, as well as a water mill, storehouse, boat shed, and kabuki theater.
