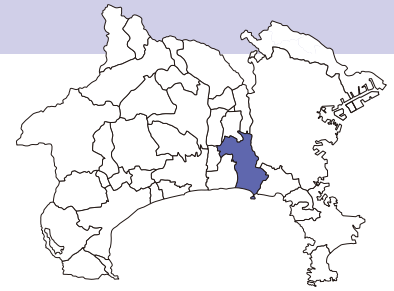

The old Enoshima Aquarium, the first modern aquarium in Japan, was reborn as the new Enoshima Aquarium in 2001. Not only can you see live and preserved animals at Enoshima Aquarium, but you can also learn as you enjoy our “edu-tainment” aquarium. It is located in a great location, with views of Mount Fuji to the west and Sagami Bay and Enoshima to the south. It is a popular filming location for movies and tv shows. There is a lot to see, including the Sagami Bay Zone, the Jellyfish Fantasy Hall, and the Sea Turtle Beach. There are also dolphin, sea lion, penguin, and jellyfish shows held daily.

Enoshima Electric Railway



A private railway full of local energy, lovingly known as "Enoden". While the line is short at only 10 km in length, you can see mountains and the sea along the route, and you can also catch glimpses of Enoshima and Mount Fuji. The many picturesque locations along the route are quite charming.
