Kannonzaki Lighthouse

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

As a pioneer of Western culture in Japan, Frenchman F.L. VERNY built the Kannonzaki Lighthouse in 1869. The current building is the 3rd one built here. It is located in the beautiful Kanagawa Public Kannonzaki Park, and you can see Boso Peninsula and ships entering and leaving Tokyo Bay from the bright white octagonal lighthouse. There is an exhibition room with materials about the lighthouse, including valuable items such as the lens used at the lighthouse.

Kannonzaki is located on the eastern tip of the Miura Peninsula, and forms the entrance to the Tokyo Bay together with the Boso Peninsula on the opposite shore. It is roughly 7 km from the lighthouse to the Boso Peninsula.

Sukanagosso



Sukanagosso is a farmer's market that sells local vegetables grown by about 400 farmers through JA Yokosuka Hayama. Here you can be sure to find fresh seasonal produce.

VERN Y Park



The garden features a bust of Oguri Kozukenosuke, a commissioner from VERNY's time. It also features French-style flower beds, fountains, and Western-style arbors centered around a plaza, and is decorated with the colors of 2,000 plants of 100 varieties of mainly French roses.
