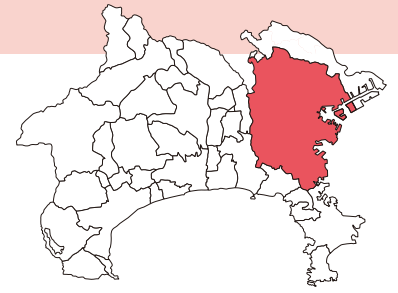

# Cupnoodles Museum

In this "interactive food-education museum," visitors can enjoyably get to learn about the importance of invention and discovery and venture mind through the exhibits about instant noodles and hands-on workshops. All the attractions are full of fun! – visitors can create a handmade Chicken Ramen at "Chicken Ramen Factory" (reservation required) and also a one-of-a-kind Cup Noodles by choosing your favorite soup and toppings in a cup designed by themselves at "My CUPNOODLES Factory" (walk-up ticket). At "NOODLES BAZAAR," an Asian-night-market-like cafeteria, various noodle dishes from around the world can be savored.

## Sky Garden, 69th floor of the Yokohama Landmark Tower



At 273 m tall, this is one of the best views from a building in Japan. In addition to the beautiful scenery of the Yokohama Minatomirai area, you can also see Tokyo Skytree and Mount Fuji on a clear day.

## Yokohama Chinatown



The largest Chinatown in Japan and East Asia is found in the vicinity of Yamashita-cho, Naka ward, Yokohama City. There are more than 500 shops, and 6,000 Chinese people live within an area of about 0.2km<sup>2</sup>
