Spring water believed to increase your money

Zeniarai Benzaiten **Ugafuku Shrine**



Explanation of Tourist Attraction When passing through a man-made cave made by gouging a giant stone from the Zeniarai Benzaiten Shrine, you will be greeted by a sacred arch tunnel made with numerous pieces of plain wood. One of the "Five Famous Springs", the money washing spring, is here. There is an oral tradition passed down, when washing your own money with this spring water, your money will increase. The "money-washing" custom has been passed down from the era of the fifth regent of the Kamakura Shogunate, Tokiyori Hojo. When Tokiyori visited this shrine, he washed his money and the prosperity of his descendants, as well as the safety of his family, came true. It is now a popular spot for many worshipers to come seek out the same benefits.

selling point

Put your money in the "bamboo basket" and use the "hishaku (ladle)" to pour the water. By using the money, it is believed to increase your financial fortune.
