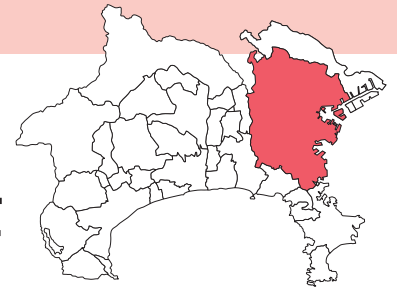

Explanation of Tourist Attraction

The Yokohama Museum of Art is famous for its powerfully symmetrical appearance and grand gallery of atrium and is one of the largest museums in Japan with seven exhibition gallery spaces and a collection of more than 12,000 art pieces. In addition to appreciating a wide range of modern and contemporary art from after the opening of the Yokohama Port, various exhibitions are held throughout the year on different themes.

The spacious facilities are also utilized to exhibit many works of modern art. About 1,000 different products are also available in the museum shop, including postcards and books, etc.

Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Kamonyama Park



Located on elevated land that looks out over Yokohama Minato Mirai 21, this park houses a bronze statue of Naosuke Ii. It is famous for its cherry blossoms and is crowded with visitors during the blossom season.
